Chairman's Message

I am very pleased to announce that, for the fifth consecutive year, your fees will remain at £120 for Full and Family membership and £60 for Sports membership. This is partly due to the good housekeeping of your Committee and the success of our events and food and beverage takings. You will shortly be receiving your invitation to rejoin and I hope that you will accept.

The fees for locker hire will also remain at £12.00 for a membership year. Members who hired a locker during 2021-22 were given complimentary hire for 2022-23 because we were unable to bowl for so much of the time since March 2020. You will, therefore, have the opportunity to hire your locker for the next year when you renew your membership by clicking on the *Visit Store* link in MemberMoJo. The few members who started their locker hire during this membership year paid the full £12.00 fee so, in order for their future renewal date to coincide with others, a pro rata fee that will take their hire period to 31 March 2024 will be charged. There are a few lockers still available for hire so if you haven't hired one before you can reserve one through MemberMoJo.

Our friendly matches will commence shortly so, even if you are not playing, please consider coming along to support your Club. Summer Opening Hours

The clocks go forward on 26 March 2023 so the gradually increasing daylight hours will mean we can bowl later in the coming months. Our Summer Opening Hours will start on Tuesday, 28 March 2023:

Opening Hours for **Bowling**

Tue-Fri – 10:30-18:30

Sat-Sun – 10:00-14:00 or later if rinks are pre-booked and a steward is available.

Kitchen and Bar Opening Hours

Our kitchen and bar are run solely by volunteers who have been trained in Food Safety, Hygiene and alcohol awareness.

The kitchen will be open whenever there is a trained volunteer on duty. Our bar-trained volunteers can serve alcohol between 12 noon and 23:00 daily.

Regular Evening Opening Hours

Wednesday Evening – 18:00-20:00 Friday Evening – 18:00-20:00

In addition to cold snacks a selection of cooked hot snacks will be available during these times.
