



## **Coronavirus (COVID-19) Statement**

The Clanfield Bowls & Sports Club is following the advice of the Government and Public Health England in the current plans for containment of the coronavirus. As such, we would advise our Members, if not already doing so, to implement the following:

- **Regular washing of hands with soap and running water for at least 20 seconds.**
- **Use of alcohol-based hand sanitisers (when soap and running water are not available).**
- **Cough or sneeze into tissues which should then be binned straight away.**
- **Don't touch your face unless you have washed your hands.**
- **Self-isolation if the member believes they may have been exposed to the virus.**

The following symptoms may develop during the 14 days after exposure to someone who has the COVID-19 infection:

- Cough
- Difficulty in breathing
- Fever

The various Bowling Associations are suggesting the courtesy of the customary handshake at the start and end of matches does not take place until the situation has improved.

None of our own planned activities over the next few weeks (including Roll Ups, Friendly Matches, Quiz, Games and Music nights, etc) are currently affected. However, we will be monitoring the situation daily and will act appropriately, if and when, the advice from the Government / Public Health England changes and we will put updates on our website when necessary.

We wish to take this opportunity to assure our Members that we are taking additional precautions to safeguard our facilities and our Members that use them. These include:

- Displaying posters providing various information relating to the coronavirus.
- Providing antibacterial soap in our cloakrooms.
- Putting antibacterial hand gel and surface cleaner in the Bowls Equipment Shed.
- Putting updates on our website regarding any changes affecting events or facilities.
